- ADA accessible stage and seating area
- Upgraded stage and flooring
- New HVAC system

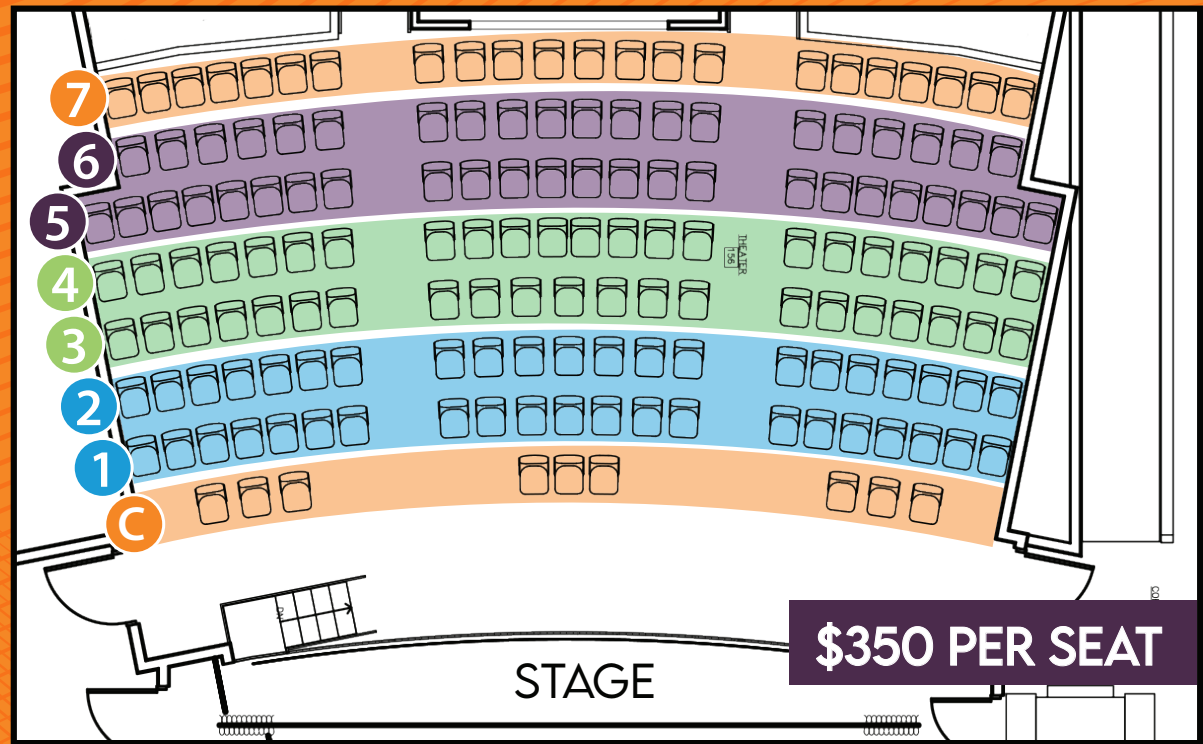

HOW TO PURCHASE NAMING RIGHTS TO SEATS:

- Theater seat plaques can be purchased online by scanning the QR Code or going to www.ketteringparksfoundation.org and clicking on the Theater seats homepage.
- In-person purchase can be made at the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts Administration building located at 3600 Shroyer Road, Kettering, Ohio 45429.
- Theater seat plaques can be purchased for \$350 per seat.
- Nine companion seats with a wheelchair/mobility device space (Aisle C) are also available for \$350 each.
- Please be prepared to enter the wording for your plaque inscription during the ordering process.
- A special Theater seat plaque will be placed in the entry vestibule of the Theater recognizing the names of all donors by seat location.
- The Theater seat naming option is considered a donation to the Rosewood Arts Center Theater and is not considered a permanent reserved seat.
